Note: Bartonella henselae is now regarded as the etiologic agent of Cat Scratch Disease, bacillary angiomatosis, endocarditis and fever with bacteremia. Bartonella quintana also causes bacillary angiomatosis particularly among immunocompromised patients, and trench fever. This test was developed and its performance characteristics determined by LabCorp. It has not been cleared or approved by the Food and Drug Administration. The FDA has determined that such clearance or approval is not necessary.
