The clinical relevance of allergen results of 0.10-0.34 kU/L are undetermined and intended for specialist use.

A positive result with penicilloyl G or penicilloyl V indicates the presence of specific IgE antibodies to penicilloyl, the major determinant of therapeutic penicillin. The absence of specific antibodies to penicilloyl does not exclude the possibility of clinically significant IgE antibodies to other penicillin metabolites.
